

March 3, 2015

The regular meeting of the Mayor and the Board of the Town of Bentonina was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Mayor Kim Tyer. The following members were present Trey Burton, Adam Brooks Kim Sligh and Clint Lancaster. Also present was Police Chief Jason Bright, Fire Chief Gary Taylor, Clerk Cannon Williams and members of the Bentonina Fire Dept, citizens and visitors.

Mr. Gary Taylor asked the board if they wished to continue spraying for mosquitoes this year and if so he had obtained price quotes on the chemical. The board advised to purchase the chemical from Jeff North.

The Mayor called for any other business to come before the board. Trey Burton made a motion to adjourn the meeting and Clint Lancaster seconding the motion. Motion passed and the meeting adjourned.
