Town Attorney spoke to the board about the updated special event ordinance and also discussed revisions for the clean up ordinance to include homes and trailer houses that are unlivable.

Changes made to the Special Event Ordinance will include, a special event fee, deposit, special 3 day privilege license for all vendors, State Department of Health certificate for any vendor preparing cooked food, sanitary requirement (port a potty), Law Enforcement, parking, clean up and other provisions. Updated Special Event Ordinance---See attachment A. Motion was made by Adam Brooks and seconded by Clint Lancaster. Votes: Kim Sligh-Yes.

Changes made to the clean up ordinance will include a fee for failure to comply, will address multiple issues to include houses and trailer houses that are unlivable. Updated Ordinance will be discussed at the next work session.
